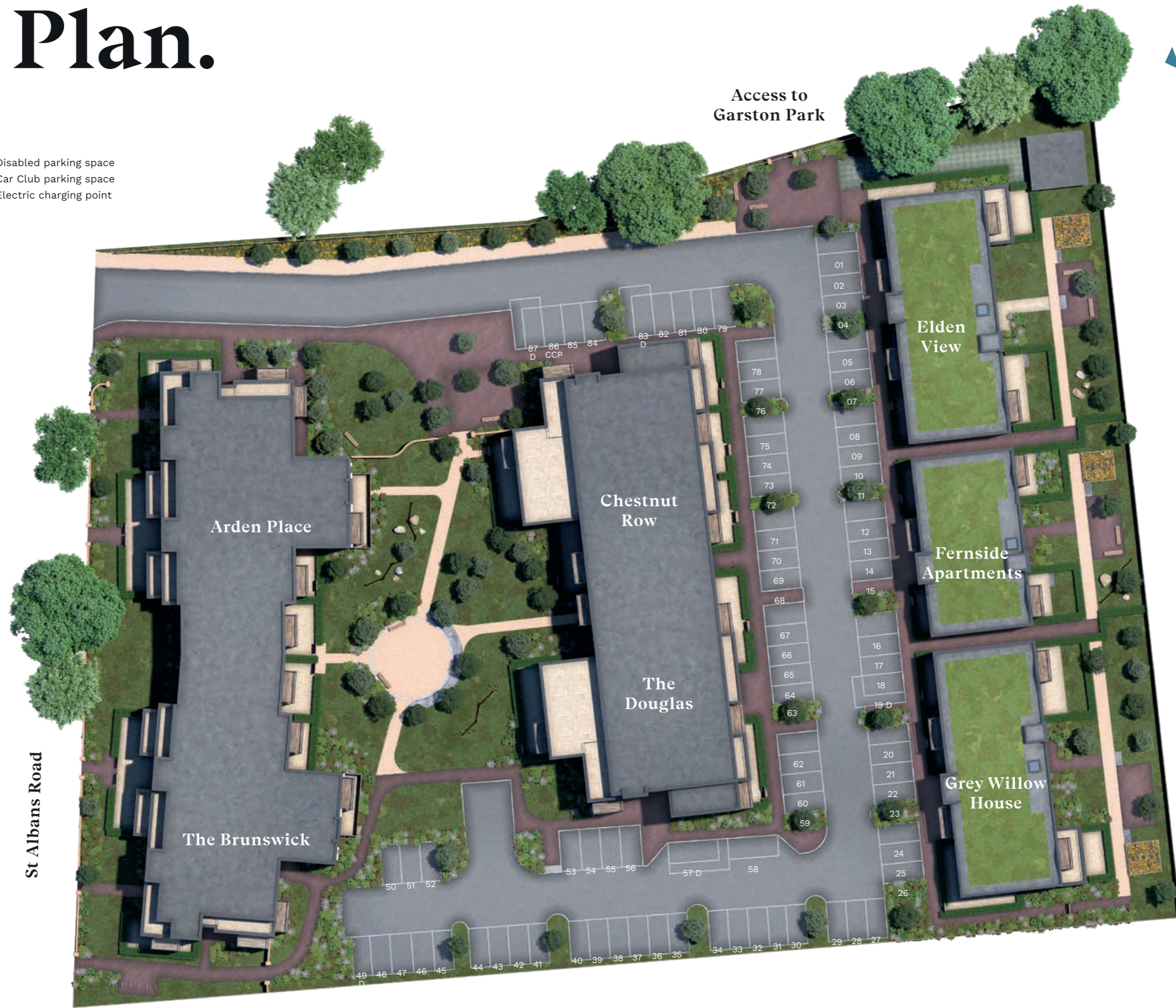
Parkside is a new community of stunning and modern 1, 2 and 3 bedroom apartments situated on St Albans Road in Garston, Watford.

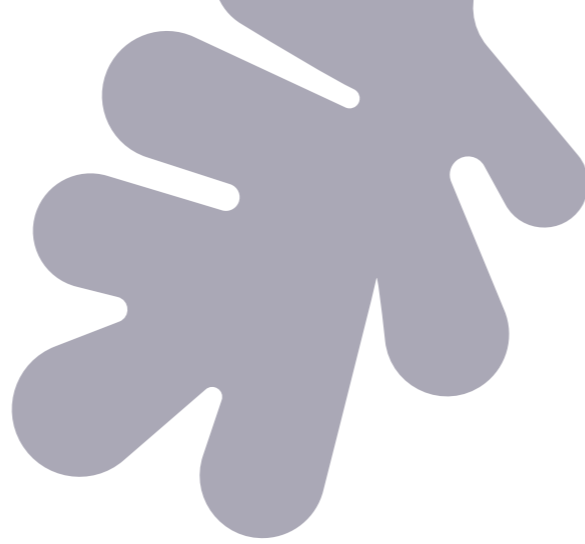


Grow your own veg patches.

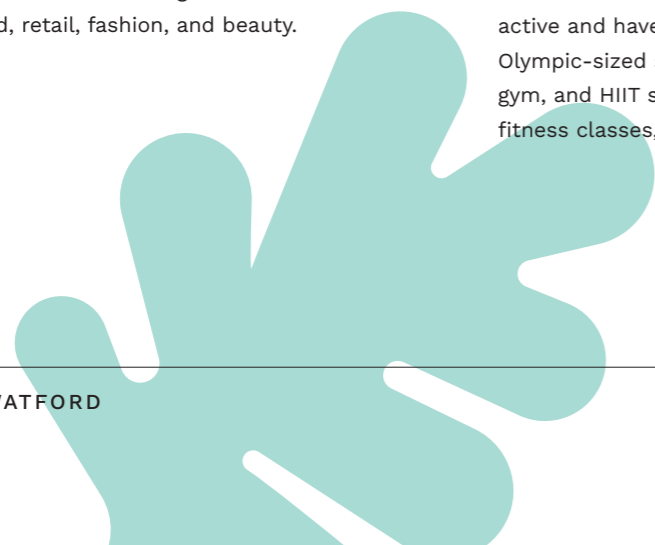

If you're looking for something more upbeat, enjoy a bottomless brunch or 2 for 1 cocktails at the vibrant Las Iguanas.

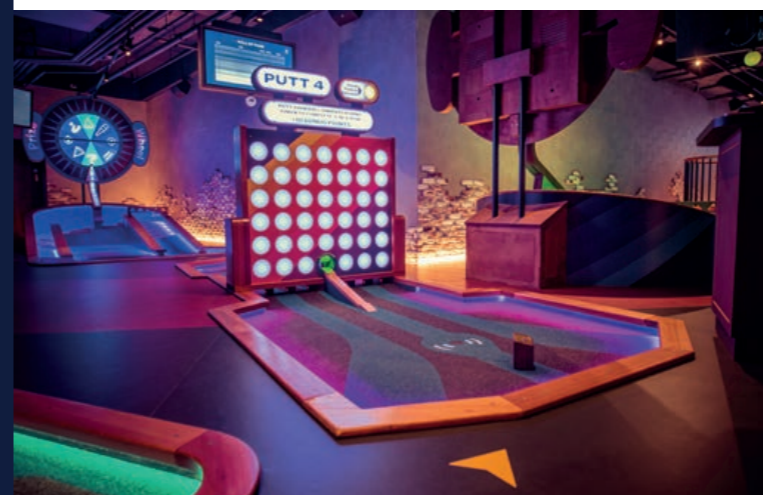
